

SAINTS

The 1st of November is known as All Saints Day. When you think about SAINTS you maybe think of patron saints – like St ANDREW, the patron saint of SCOTLAND who was a FISHERMAN and one of Jesus' disciples. Or St GEORGE, the patron saint of England who slayed a DRAGON. Then there's St DAVID, the patron saint of Wales and St PATRICK of IRELAND.

You maybe think of special people in history. In the big stained glass window in Melrose Church there are pictures of 2 saints – St MARGARET, Queen of Scotland and St CUTHBERT who was a Prior of Melrose Abbey and later Bishop of Lindisfarne.

You maybe think of Saints for special things. St CHRISTOPHER is the patron saint of travellers. St VALENTINE is the patron saint of love, St FRANCIS the patron saint of animals, and St JUDE the patron saint of lost causes!

But saints are not just big names or important people, they're not just people from long ago..... we are all saints as well.

Saint is another word for a FOLLOWER of JESUS, another word for the PEOPLE of GOD. God chooses the most unlikely people, the most ordinary people to be saints. So, we are all saints, followers of Jesus, God's people.
